## Eugene, Oregon

Eugene is located in the Willamette Valley with hiking trails, lakes, waterfalls, the scenic Oregon coast, and the Willamette and Deschutes National Forests all within easy driving distance. Eugene is one of the largest cities in Oregon and is located approximately two hours south of Portland. It is known as 'Track Town, USA' for hosting Olympic Trials, NCAA championships, numerous professional, international, and collegiate meets, and several marathons, as well as boasting a strong community of runners and supporters.

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The Eugene VA Health Care Center is one of three satellite clinics associated with the Roseburg VA Health Care System, which serves over 27,000 Veterans throughout central and Southern Oregon and Northern California.

## Our Program

We accept one resident each year for a 12-month ASHP accredited program, which begins in early July. The resident will work directly with pharmacists who have scopes of practice, prescriptive authority, and manage patients with multiple disease states. Throughout the residency year, the resident will partake in longitudinal clinical experiences.

Application materials must be submitted through PhORCAS and a four-hour, onsite interview is required. Our interviews include a group interview with preceptors along with a tour of the site.
